To aid our members in recruiting new members, the Membership Committee is authorizing pizza parties for prospective members. The idea is to host a party at your workplace where you can make others aware of the benefits of being a member of AGA! To be eligible the parties must adhere to the rules below and be approved in advance by the Membership Committee. This offer is valid as long as funds are available. So throw a party and signup new members!

### **Rules for pizza parties:**

1. Pizza parties must be approved in advance by the Membership Committee.
2. Any member may submit a request to the Membership Committee for a party at their workplace.
3. The request should include a list of all those expected to attend.
4. There should be at least one prospective member for each member in attendance at the party.
5. At least three prospective members should be committed to attend for a party to be approved.
6. The requesting member should obtain membership applications for distribution at the party and should make a small presentation extolling the benefits of membership.
7. After the party the requesting member should submit a list of those actually in attendance, their job titles, and a receipt for reimbursement to the membership committee.
8. Items eligible for reimbursement are: pizza, soft drinks, dessert, paper plates, plasticware, and cups.
9. It would be the intent of the Membership Committee that only one party per year be permitted for any targeted area.
10. Parties would be approved on a first come, first served basis as long as funds allow.
