Points for Recruiting Volunteers:

A member has an opportunity to earn a maximum of 2 additional points for recruiting a volunteer for any community service project. Points for recruiting will be awarded as stated below:

- 1 point for recruiting a volunteer that has not previously volunteered for any event or made a donation in any amount.
- 1 point for the project in which a member recruited a volunteer that has not previously volunteered for that particular event.
